

**VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR CHILDREN  
BELOW 15 YEARS OF AGE TRAVELLING TO THE PHILIPPINES  
UNACCOMPANIED BY PARENTS AND STAYING MORE THAN 21 DAYS**

1. Duly accomplished visa application form
2. 2" x 2" photograph
3. Passport valid for at least six months beyond date of intended travel
4. Notarized Affidavit of Consent from parent(s)
5. Photocopy of child's ticket/travel itinerary
6. Photocopies of data page of passport of child's traveling companion and travel itinerary
7. Thirty dollars (\$30) visa fee – in cash, postal money order, bank draft or cashier's /manager's check payable to the Philippine Consulate General

**WAIVER OF EXCLUSION GROUND (WEG)**

A guardian or either parent of the minor children below fifteen (15) years old who are holding foreign passports and who are traveling unaccompanied by or not joining a parent in the Philippines must apply for Waiver of Exclusion Ground (WEG) at the Consulate in order to be admitted regardless of whether the minor is visa free (under E.O. 408) or not. WEG and visa are two different things that are applied for and granted independently of each other by BI and DFA, respectively. A minor, even with approved WEG order, may still be excluded if he does not have entry visa, if such is required.

The following documents must be filed at the Bureau of Immigration- Ninoy Aquino International Airport Field Office upon arrival of said minor children:

- a) Affidavit of Consent of either parent naming the person who will accompany the child and with whom the child will reside in the Philippines;
- b) Data page of the child's passport ; and
- c) Data page of the accompanying adult's passport.

A WEG fee of PhP3,500 must be paid to the Bureau of Immigration
